Home Supplies For Your Surgery Laith M. Jazrawi M.D.

Dr. Jazrawi has given you directions concerning the care of your incision after you leave the hospital. He has told you when you can take a shower and how to handle your dressing changes. If you have questions, please feel free to clarify with our staff any instructions prior to leaving the hospital.

Open Surgery

- **A.** Open knee surgery:
 - a. You will need a 9" by 3" Bandaids or waterproof dressings for fourteen days. Also, a box of 4" by 4" gauze sponges.
- **B.** Open hip surgery:
 - a. You will need two 9" by 3" dressings (total length of 18") for fourteen days. Also, a box of 4" by 4" gauze sponges.
- **C.** Open shoulder surgery:
 - a. You will need a 3" by 3" Bandaids or waterproof dressings for fourteen days. Also, a box of 4" by 4" gauze sponges.

Arthroscopic Surgery

- **A.** For Arthroscopic shoulder, knee, or elbow surgery:
 - a. You will need a 3" by 3" Bandaids for 4-5 days. You will usually have two to three scope sites.
- **B.** Local-area Walmart and K-mart have the waterproof dressings, but they are a special order item and you will have to purchase these through their pharmacy.
