## Post-Operative Instructions Open Elbow Surgery

## **First Post-Operative Day**

- **A.** Continue ice pack every one to two hours while awake for at least twenty minutes or Cryocuff/gameready. Ice brace as per instructions.
- **B.** Pain medication as needed every four hours.
- C. Antibiotics for 4 days.

## **Second Post-Operative Day**

- **A.** Continue ice pack every one to two hours while awake and pain meds as needed.
- **B.** Keep Splint intact and dry. Do not change dressing.

## **Suture Removal**

**A.** Staples will be removed 10-14 days after surgery.

Any activity that requires precise thinking and accuracy must be avoided for the first twelve hours after surgery, which includes operating machinery and or driving a vehicle.
